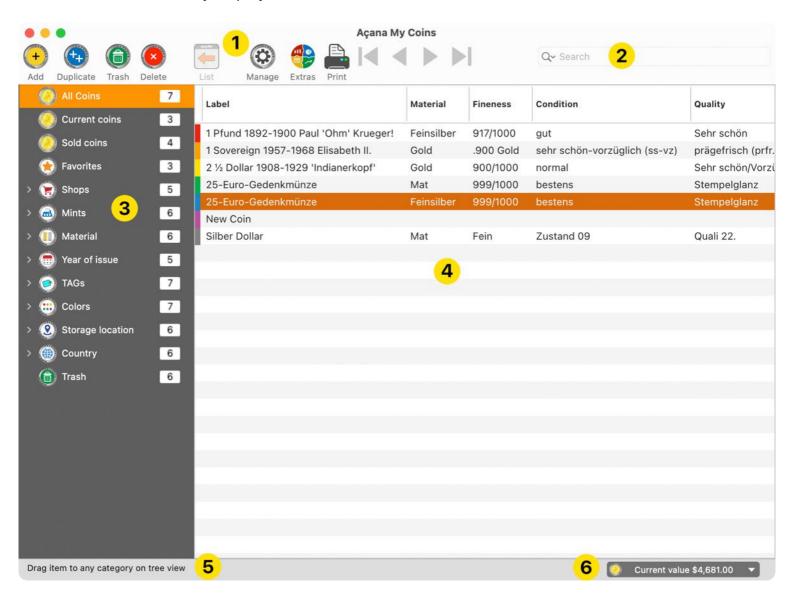

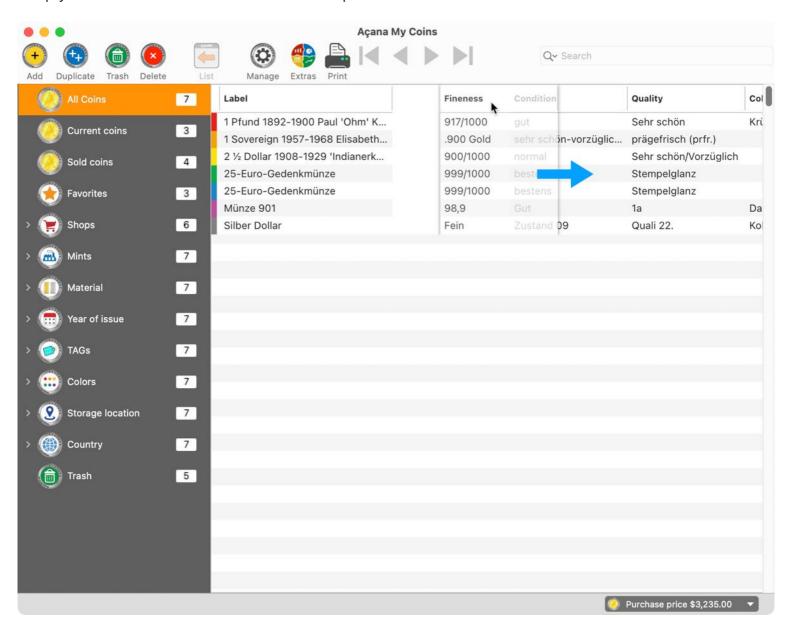
CUSTOMIZE LISTS

The coin and ingots lists can be freely configured. All settings are saved and are reassigned to the lists when the program is restarted.

- Calculate column widths automatically (see settings: Lists)
- Set column widths manually (see <u>settings</u>: Lists)

- Show or hide columns
- Reset lists to default values

Arrange columns

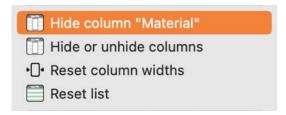
Simply move the desired column to the new position.



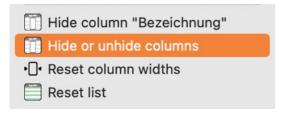


Hide or unhide columns

The current column can be hidden via the context menu.



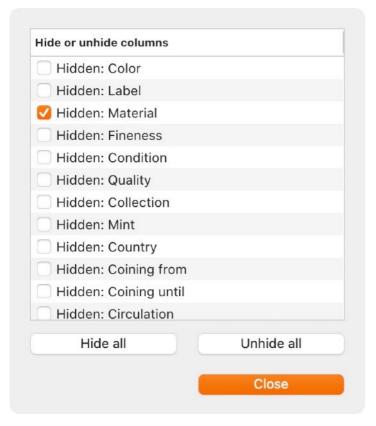
Several columns can easily be shown or hidden via an options window. To do this, use "Show or hide columns" from the context menu.



You can also open the options window via the toolbar menu. To do this, select "Extras -> Columns".



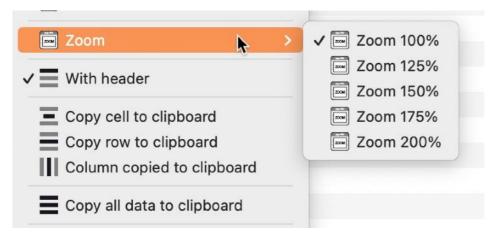

The lists can be quickly enlarged via the context menu. The zoom factor for the lists can be set from 50% to 400% in the <u>settings</u>.



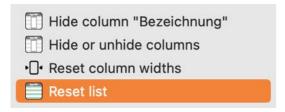
Reset column widths

The column width of all columns can be set to the default values. To do this, use the context menu.

The list can also be reset to the default values. To do this, use the context menu.





TOTALS

In the main window, the totals of the currently visible coins are listed in the list view.



The following sums are available:

- ∑ Current value (total value of field "current value" * purchase count)
- ∑ Purchase price (total value of field "price" * purchase count)
- ∑ Stock (total value of field "price" * purchase count-sold count)
- \(\sums \) Selling price (total value of field "price sold" * sold count)

If a total is not available in a list view, the first sum from the list is automatically displayed. If no totals are available, the totals selection is not available.





ASSIGN PROPERTIES VIA DRAG AND DROP

Properties can be assigned to the coins in the list by dragging and dropping them onto the categories in the tree structure without having to call up the details. Drag a coin from the "Description" column to any category.



The following allocations are possible:

Coins, ingots, medals and bundles of all categories

Target: Favorites

• The selected entry is added to the favorites

Target: Shops

The assigned shop is removed from the selected entry

Target: A shop from the shops category

The shop is assigned to the selected entry

• The TAG is assigned to the selected entry

Target: Colors

The assigned color is removed from the selected entry

• The color is assigned to the selected entry

Target: Storage location

The assigned storage location is removed from the selected entry

Target: A storage location from the storage location category

The deposit location is assigned to the selected entry

Target: Country

The assigned country is removed from the selected entry

Target: A country from the Country category

The country is assigned to the selected entry

The selected entry is moved to the trash

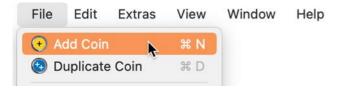
The categories "All entries", "Coins", "Ingots", "Medals", "Bundles", "Current" and "Sold" cannot be assigned using "drag and drop".



A new coin/ingot is added in the toolbar menu via the "Add" icon.

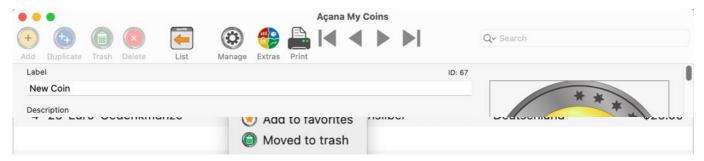

A new entry with the title "New entry" is created and the details are displayed. Now fill in the required fields.



- When creating new entries, the following default values are set
 - The default type (coin, ingot, medal, bundle) is automatically set according to the selected entry in the selection menu (including all sub-groups).
 - These are the titles for a new entry
 - New entry
 - New coin
 - New ingot
 - New medal
 - New bundle



DUPLICATE ENTRY

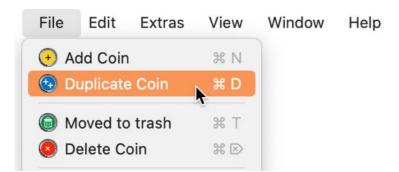




A coin/ingot is duplicated in the toolbar menu via the "Duplicate" icon.



Or select "Menu -> File -> Duplicate coin".



You can also use the context menu for this.



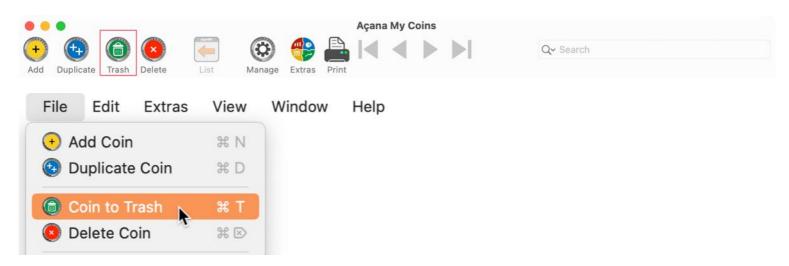
The name of the copied coin is given the extension "COPY". Attachments and additional images are not duplicated.



MOVE ENTRY TO TRASH



Select one or more coins/ingots from the list and click on the "Trash" icon in the toolbar menu.



Or select "Menu -> File -> Move to trash".



You can also use the context menu "Move to trash".

RESTORE ENTRY FROM TRASH



First select "Trash" in the category structure on the left. Now select one or more coins/ingots in the list and select "Restore from trash" in the context menu.

EMPTY TRASH



First select "Trash" in the category structure on the left. The recycle bin can be emptied via the "Empty trash" context menu.



This will delete all entries that are in the trash. The following items assigned to the entries will also be deleted:

- Cover picture
- additional pictures
- all attachments

This command cannot be undone!

You can also empty the trash can via the display menu in the "All entries", "Coins" and "Bars" sections. To do this, select the trash can in the corresponding section and select "Empty trash can" from the context menu.



MARK ENTRY WITH COLORS



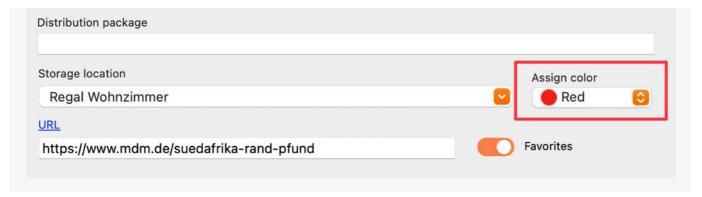
For easier identification, the coins and ingots in the list (in the main window) can be marked with a color. The assigned colors are also visible in the "List of all coins" window. The following colors are available:

- Red
- Orange
- Yellow
- Green
- Blue
- Purple
- Gray

The color can be assigned and removed via the context menu. Several entries can also be assigned a color at once.

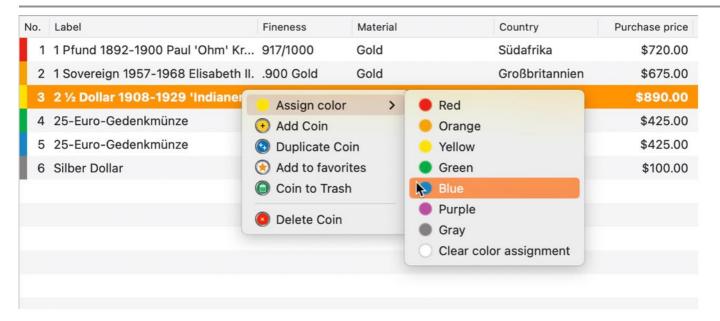

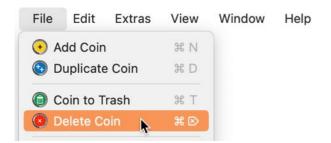


DELETE ENTRY

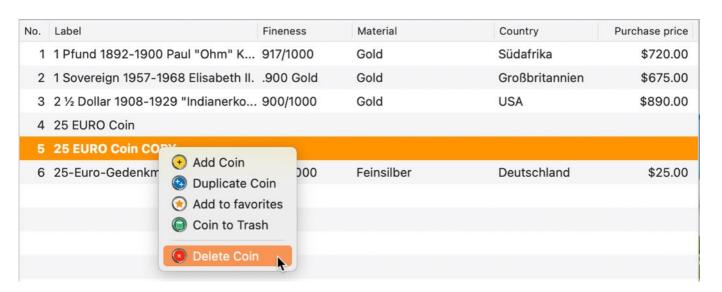
One or more coins/ingots can be deleted via the "Delete" icon in the toolbar menu.

SHARE ENTRY

To share a coin/ingot via the sharing services available in the system, click on the share symbol on the right-hand side below the image. In the <u>settings</u>, you can specify which details should be shared.











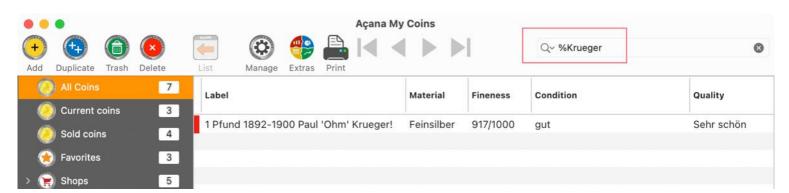
SEARCH ENTRIES

To search for coins and ingots, enter the name or part of the name you are looking for in the search field and. The standard search is always "Starts with". If you want to search for a coin that contains a specific text, use the % sign at the beginning of the search term.

Example search string: 25



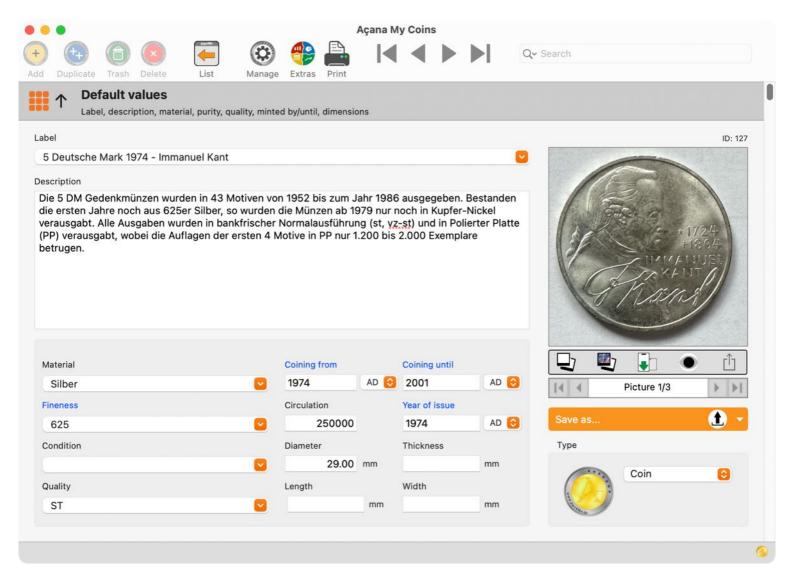

SHOW / EDIT DETAILS

Double-click on a coin/ingot in the list to call up the details. Right in the toolbar menu you can easily scroll through the list of coins without leaving the details. Click on the "List" icon to return to the list of coins. You can also do this using the key combination $\Re \leftarrow$.





SAVE DETAILS AS PDF, DOCX, XLSX OR TXT FILE

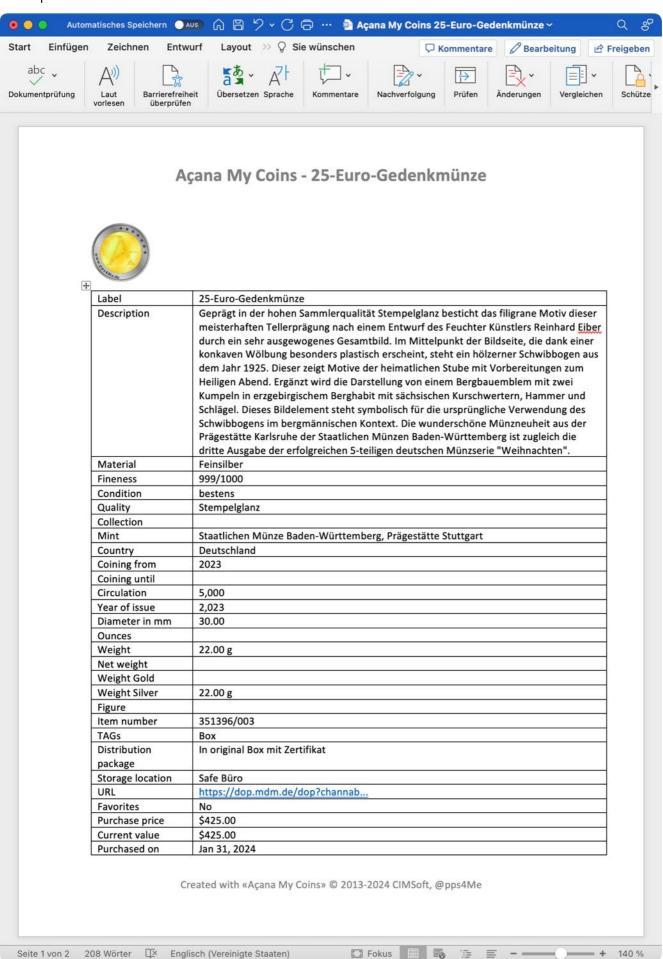
The details can be saved as a PDF, Word® DOCX, Excel® XLSX or TXT file. To do this, select "Save details as..." in the details menu.



In the export files (DOCX or PDF), the fields that also contain a value are always in the output. In the PDF format, you can select in the <u>settings</u> whether the "Description" field should be exported. If this is set, a second page is created in the PDF document with the content of the "Description" field. If the content is larger than one page, the text is shortened.

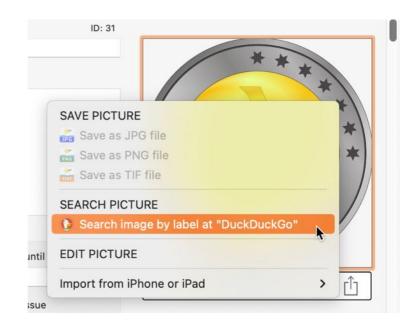
ADD, COPY, SAVE OR REMOVE A PICTURE

To add a picture to a coin/ingot, drag any graphic into the picture area. You can add a picture from Finder, Safari or any other program using drag and drop.



If you do not have a suitable image for your coin, you can have «Açana My Coins» search for an image using a search engine on the Internet. Select "Search image with name" in the context menu. One of the following search engines can be set as the default search engine in the settings:

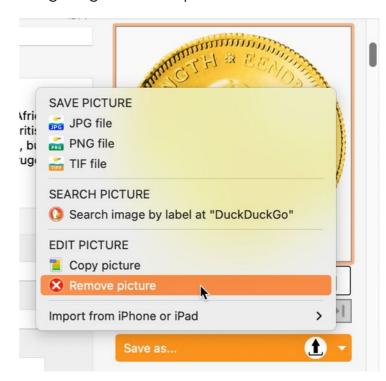

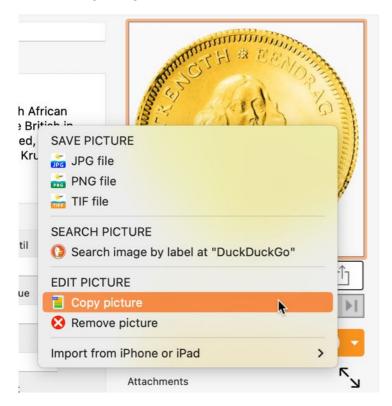


An image can also be inserted via the clipboard. An existing image can be copied via the context menu.



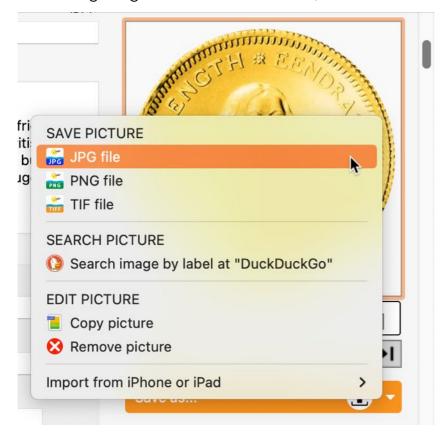


An existing image can be deleted via the context menu.

An existing image can be viewed with the preview function using the space bar. To do this, click on the image with the mouse. A border appears around the image indicating that the focus is now on this element. The preview function is activated by pressing the space bar on the keyboard. Press the space bar on the keyboard again to exit the preview function.

All images of the coin can be viewed quickly using the preview function.

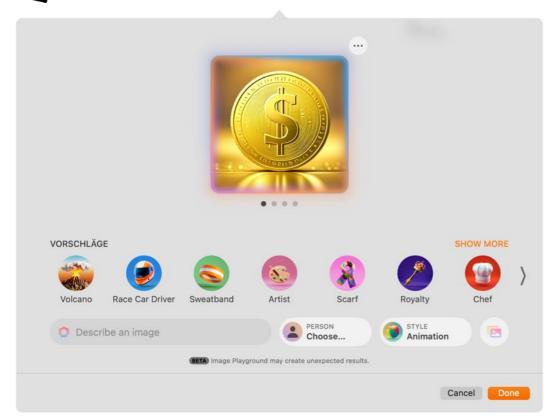


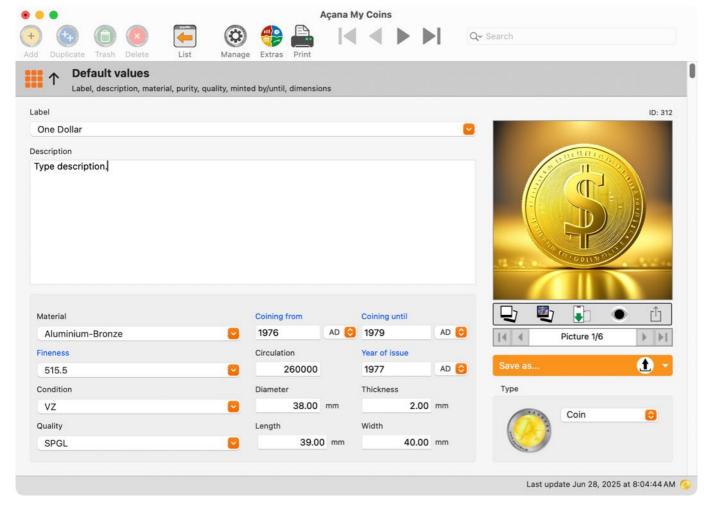




Using the "Image Playground" feature in macOS (requires macOS 15 or higher and a Mac with Apple CPU), you can use AI to create images and add them to the current entry.









SAVE OR COPY PICTURE VIA "DRAG AND DROP"

The existing images (cover image, additional images and attachments) can be saved as a graphic file using "drag and drop" in the Finder. The export format to be used can be specified in the settings.

The following file formats are available:

- BMP
- GIF
- JPG
- JPE2 (JPEG2000)
- PNG
- TGA
- TIF
- WebP

An existing image can also be dragged and dropped into any program and is available there as a graphic.



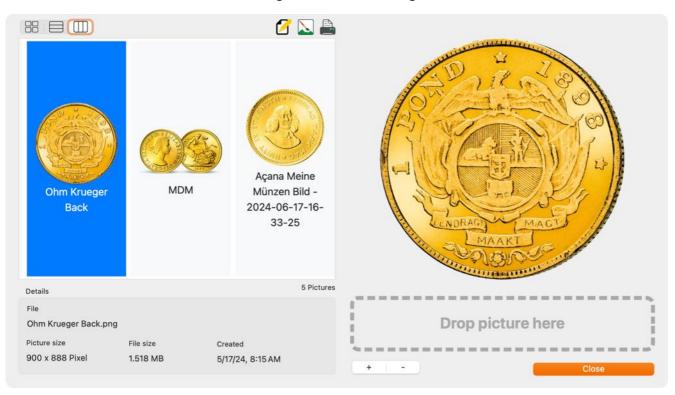


ADD ADDITIONAL PICTURES

Any number of additional images can be added to each coin. Select a coin from the list by double-clicking on it. Then click on the "Multi-Picture" icon.



You can add or delete additional images in the following window.



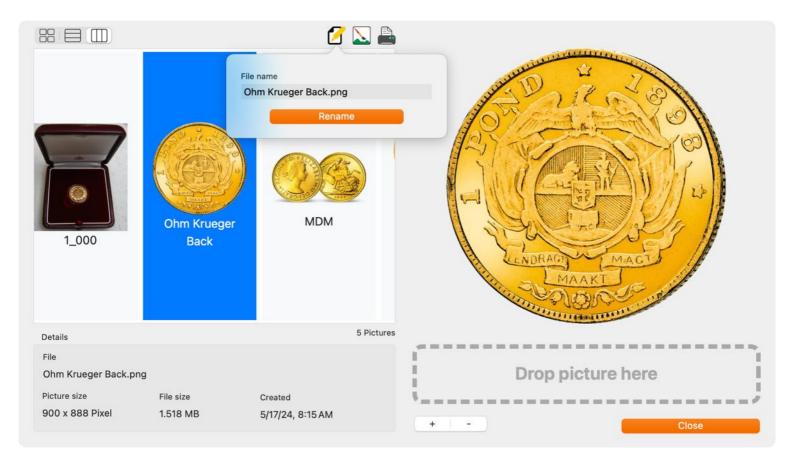

You can rename the additional pictures. Click on the rename icon.





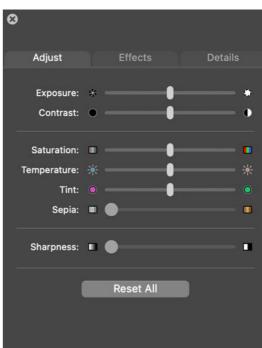
EDIT ADDITIONAL PICTURES

In the "Edit" window you can do some adjustments and apply different effects to the picture, like you can do it with the macOS application "Preview".

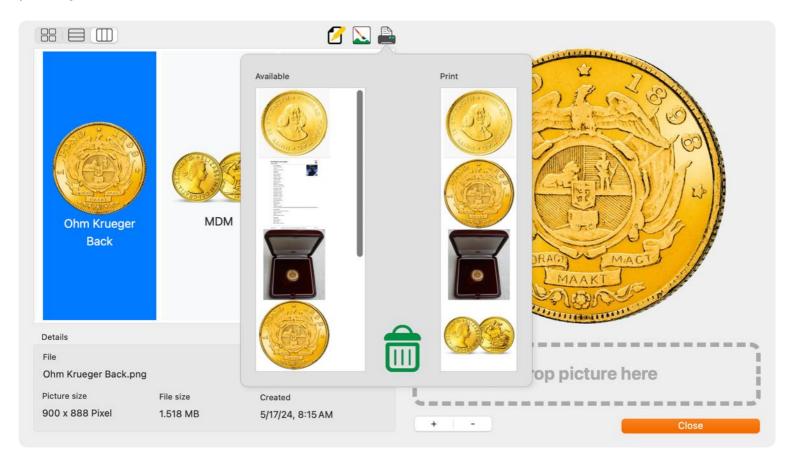






SETUP ADDITIONAL PICTURES FOR PRINT IN DETAILS

To setup and arrange additional pictures for print in details, click on the "Print" icon. In this window you can drag the available picture on the left side into the "Print" area. In the "Print" area your can arrange the pictures by dragging up or down. You can also delete and entry by selecting one picture or drag it on the "Trash" icon. You can close this window by pressing "ESC" on your keyboard on click on the additional pictures window. A maximum of 4 pictures can be defined, which are then used when printing the details.



You can also assign the pictures to be printed directly in the details. To do this, click on the "Print" symbol in the top left corner of the cover picture.

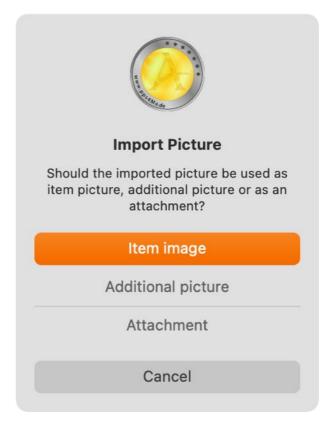

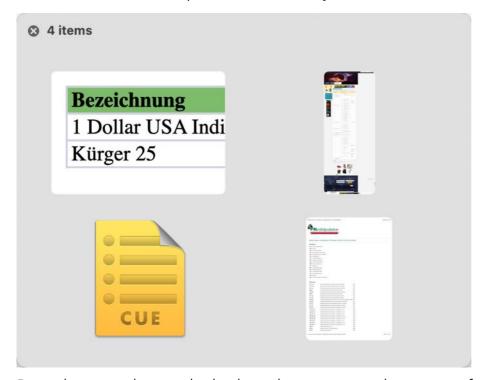


MANAGE ATTACHMENTS

Any number of attachments can be added to each coin. Select a coin from the list by double-clicking on it. Then switch to the "Attachments" area.



The attachments can be viewed using the preview function. To do this, select one or more attachments from the list. Press the space bar on the keyboard to activate the preview.



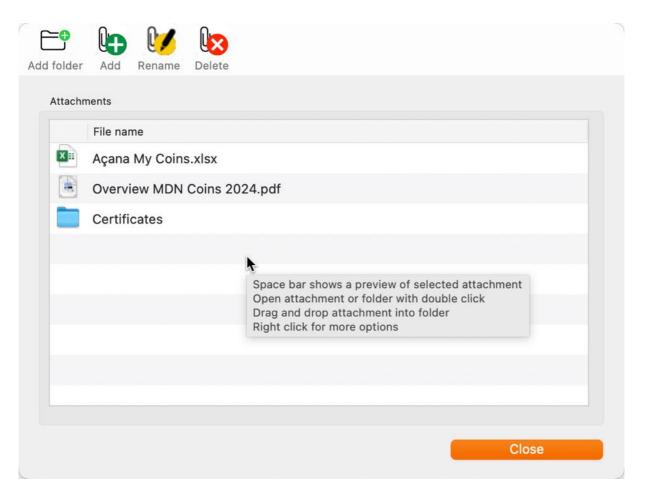
Press the space bar on the keyboard again to exit the preview function.



Attachments are added, renamed or deleted in a separate window. This window can be opened by clicking on the following icon.



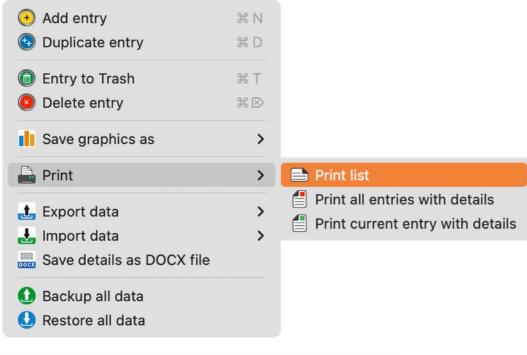

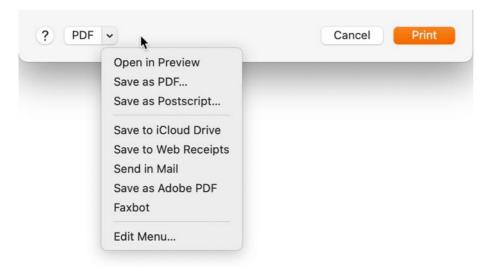
PRINT ALL ENTRIES WITH DETAILS

To print all coins with details, select "Menu => File => Print => Print all coins with details", or select the corresponding icon in the toolbar menu.



The print output can be previewed here. The icons in the toolbar menu (|< < > >|) can be used to scroll through the entries. The output can be saved to a file using the "DOCX", "PDF", "HTML" and "XLSX" icons. In the "DOCX", "PDF" and "XLSX" formats, all pages are saved in one file. In the "HTML" format, only the currently displayed page is saved. The "Print" icon can be used to output via a printer and all output devices or output services available in the system.

The "Description" column cannot be printed as the content may be too large.

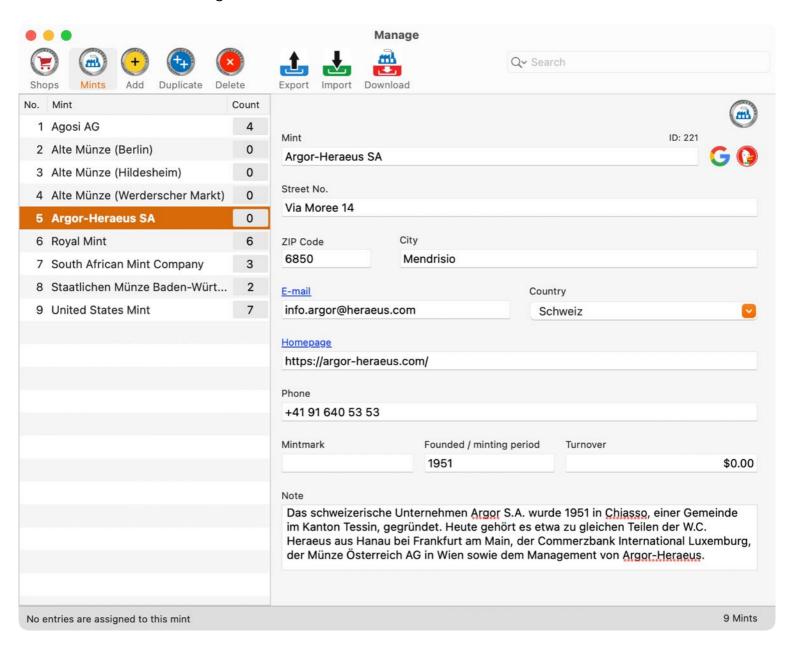


MANAGE MINTS

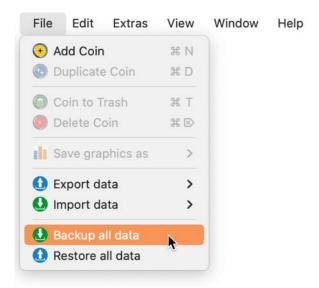




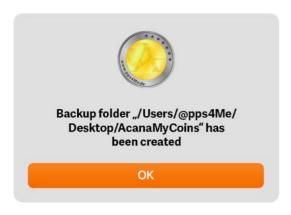


BACKUP ALL DATA
